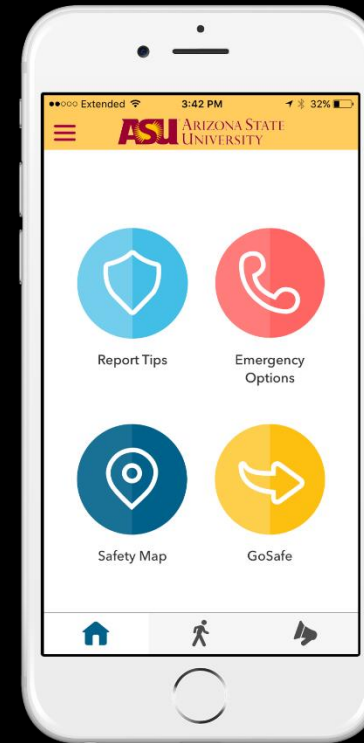

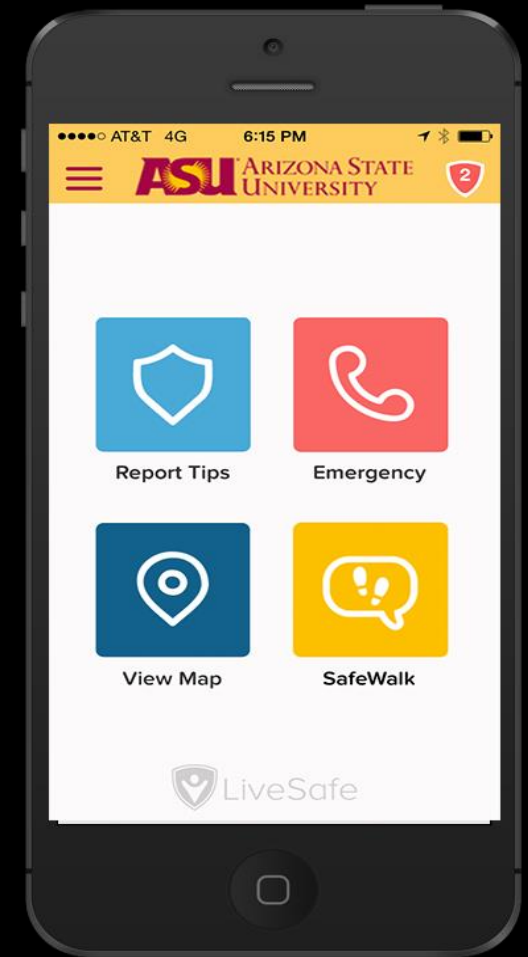

- **Send tips to the ASU Police Department**

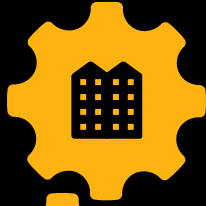

Off Campus Safety Tips



Lock Doors- 60% of theft in Tempe happens when doors are left unlocked. No keys under mats.



Put Away Valuables in Cars and Lock the Doors.



Register Bikes with ASU Police or Tempe Police. This is the #1 Crime in Tempe.



There is safety in numbers. Know your route and travel with friends.



Use the on-campus Safety Escort Service 7 days a week- 7pm to 1:30am. (480) 965-1515.



Download the ASU LiveSafe App.



If you see something suspicious, say something. Call the Tempe non-emergency number at 480-350-8311.

Living Well Off-Campus

- **Communicate With Your Apartment Community Staff
(Call in Repairs, Give 60 days notice for Moving Out)**
- **Understand Your Lease- Ask questions**
- **Request a copy of your lease**
- **Only sign for 1 lease**

Keep Personal Information Secure

- **Don't share your Personal Information**
- **If people you don't know ask you for personal information- you can say NO!**
- **Be aware of SCAMS!!**
- **Example call: This is the IRS calling to discuss money you owe. Please call us at 877-900-9000 and provide your name, date of birth. We will be prepared to collect fees over the phone.**
- **If you receive a call from a USA Government Office, please note that they only send out written communication.**
